



Sparham Hall Farm Holiday Cottages - Dog Policy

Although Sparham Hall Farm Holiday Cottages are dog friendly, we do adopt a strict dog policy. This is due to the cottages being located on a working family farm where both children, family dogs and farm livestock live. It is also to protect our properties and for the benefit and comfort of all guests who come to stay with us.

1. Only one medium-sized well-behaved dog is allowed in each cottage at any one time. Please note, that dogs considered to be dangerous breeds are not accepted.
2. We charge an additional £5 per day for a dog to stay.
3. We reserve the right to refuse any booking that we feel is not appropriate.
4. Full details, including the name and breed of dog must be given at the time of booking.
5. On arrival, should the pet you have brought not reflect those details given at the time of booking, we reserve the right to refuse occupation. In these circumstances, the cost of your holiday less your deposit will be kept by us to compensate for our loss of earnings of the booking.
6. In consideration of our other and future guests, pet owners are responsible for cleaning up and disposing of all pet refuse.
7. For the consideration of future guests at the accommodation, please note that dogs are not allowed on the furniture or in the bedrooms at any time. Any evidence of dogs on furniture or bedding will incur extra cleaning costs which will be deducted from your breakage deposit.
8. A Mud Daddy is available for washing down muddy/sandy pets. We also supply doggy towels for use with your pet. Please ensure your pets are clean and dry before allowing them into the accommodation. Please do not use the shower in the bathroom to clean your pet.
9. Pets should be treated with flea and tick repellent prior to arrival. The cost of dealing with any infestation caused by your pet will be deducted from your breakage deposit.
10. We assume no responsibility for illness or injury that may occur to your pet whilst you are staying in the holiday accommodation. Details of the local Vets in Taverham can be found on the Guidebook.
